



Free Fruit Trees for Camden Residents Apples, Peaches, Pears, and More!

Attention, Camden residents! If you grow food in a community or backyard garden you are eligible for a free fruit tree this fall!

Trees are **FREE** of charge for **all Camden residents**. You **MUST** attend our one-hour workshop to receive a fruit tree. **If selected, trees will be available for pick up at our workshop on Saturday, September 9th from 9:00am-11:00am.**

The trees must be planted by you and your gardeners. The NJ Tree Foundation will teach you to plant, maintain, and harvest your fruit trees.

Fruit trees require 6-8 hours of sun and should be planted in well drained soils (meaning the soil does not hold water for too long). The trees also need space to grow. Most trees will be semi-dwarfing (12-15' tall/wide at maturity), although some standard trees (18'+ tall/wide at maturity) may be available.

Trees will be 4' tall upon pick-up and will be available in several varieties. If you have a special request, please note it on the application.



Don't delay! Fruit trees are first come, first served and our supply is limited.
